Signpost Stockport for Carers	Social opportunities, such as nature walks and visits to pubs and cafes, for carers aged over 50 in Stockport to meet and enjoy mutual support

Warm Hut	Time to Talk project providing activities and social space for older asylum seekers and refugees in Salford and Manchester to enjoy mutual support and reconnect after isolation during the pandemic
Widows Empowerment Trust	A telephone-based befriending project helping BAME women over 50 to reconnect and re-engage in social activities in Manchester
Women of Worth	A trauma-informed self-care and wellbeing project focusing on empowerment and connection for older BAME women in Trafford
Yaran North West	Movie and nostalgia nights providing social connection for older members of the Iranian and Afghan communities
