Age UK Bolton	Bolton - Farnworth and Kearsley	£2,000.00	Promoting Active Lives Project (PALs) is a befriending project in which volunteers will be recruited and trained to support older Farnworth and Kearsley residents to integrate back into their community as Covid-19 restrictions ease.
Bolton at Home - Campbell House	Bolton - Farnworth and Kearsley	£819.20	Pottery painting sessions will be delivered for the residents of Campbell House, with lunch and refreshments provided to participants.
Bolton at Home - Highfield House Sheltered Scheme	Bolton - Farnworth and Kearsley	£1,281.40	A series of cinema afternoons and lunches for Highfield House residents, provided by The Video Box. An evening party with refreshments and entertainment will also be held.

Farnworth Baptist Church	Bolton - Farnworth and Kearsley	£1,990.00	The project will encourage older Farnworth residents to attend the newly opened Renew Well café space by making the venue more accessible, holding more activities and publicising locally.

Precious Gems	Bolton - Farnworth and Kearsley	£2,000.00	The 'Music for Soul' project is for a singing group at Kearsley Mount Methodist Church. The main activity in each session will be singing but other activities like crochet and knitting will also take place.

Communic8te Bury	Bury - Bury East	£2,000.00	The project will recruit and train 8 Community Champions in preparation for a BAME outreach project.

Friends of Hazel Wood High School	Bury - Bury East	£1,750.00	A hairdressing and nail service for Bury East residents over the age of 50, delivered by trainee students under staff supervision. The funding will cover the purchase of 3 nail bars, 20 tavares, nail and hand massage materials and chairs for the waiting area.
Jinnah Day Care Centre	Bury - Bury East	£2,000.00	Project Healthy Lives Matter will be of a programme of organised activities, health talks, therapies and art workshops designed for the older Bury East South Asian population.
Moving On Together	Bury - Bury East	£660.00	The funding will support the group to resume activities that were impacted by the pandemic and make the meeting more accessible to former carers over the age of 50 in the Bury East area.
New Springs Community Project Group	Bury - Bury East	£1,860.00	A series of activities, workshops and events, for older isolated residents of the Springs estate. Monthly social events will also be piloted.
The Met	Bury - Bury East	£1,612.50	The 'Meet Me at the Met' project involve a series of bi-weekly sessions at The Met to talk, share experiences, learn about the arts programmes and try arts activities.
Walnut Avenue Allotments	Bury - Bury East	£850.00	The project will support the launch of a Winter Warmer lunch group for Bury East residents
Active Youth Foundation	Manchester - Gorton	£2,000.00	The funding is to implement the 'Stay Afloat Project'. It will involve both a face to face and e-program sessions for older residents of Gorton to engage in physical activities, such as table tennis.

Art and craft materials will be purchased and posted to the participants (if required).
Healthy Me Healthy Communities	Manchester - Gorton	£2,000.00	Engagement events and activities to involve older Gorton residents in the co-design of activities and services. The engagement events will include creative art workshops, cultural bread making workshops and social eating events.
Ryder Brow Community Allotment Society	Manchester - Gorton	£2,000.00	A 5-week guided art and wellbeing workshop for Gorton residents over the age of 50. The sessions will take place in the community allotment and be facilitated by a practitioner.
Ryder Brow Community Allotment Society	Manchester - Gorton	£1,999.13	To fund adaptations to make community plot 24 more accessible and make the community plot hub more age-friendly, including the installation of a handrail, clear signage and a notice board.

A community navigation scheme will support people to develop personalised action plans with signposting and referrals to relevant services. A befriending and mentoring scheme will also run alongside the community navigation.
The Friends of Debdale Park	Manchester - Gorton	£1,750.00	Nature and wildlife sessions in and around Debdale park for older Gorton residents, including bird walks, bat walks, bug ID sessions and tree walks. Equipment for the walks will be provided as well as refreshments.

Warm Hut UK	Manchester - Gorton	£2,000.00	The project will encourage older BAME Gorton residents to take part in weekly physical activity. Drop in sessions to take place twice a week incorporating fitness activities, led by a cultural health coach, and general information and advice. Refreshments will also be provided.
Yaran Northwest	Manchester - Gorton	£2,000.00	A series of social events for older Gorton residents in the Farsi, Arabic, Kurdish speaking and South Asian Communities.
Albemarle Allotment Association	Manchester - Withington and Old Moat	£1,927.12	To fund two seating areas will be created for the allotments, including four benches and paving slabs.
Ladbybarn Community Hub	Manchester - Withington and Old Moat	£2,000.00	A series of weekly wellbeing workshops, including floristry, arts and crafts, wellbeing, yoga/tai-chi.
Sonder Radio	Manchester - Withington and Old Moat	£2,000.00	A series of weekly drop in Radio and Wellbeing sessions, delivered by the Sonder Radio team will take place over 6 weeks and include creative writing, music making and presenting activities.

Real Vision Community Network CIC	Oldham - St James'	£2,000.00	A 5-week digital skills training project and a tablet loan service to help people aged 50 and over from St James' to become more digitally connected.
Arnold Bagnall Court Residents Social Fund	Rochdale - Kirkholt	£1,455.00	A one-off themed event based on "Blackpool – a day at the seaside" followed by a series of follow up activities for people aged 50 and over who live at Arnold Bagnall Court, a Sheltered Housing Scheme in Kirkholt, which will help create social connections between residents and reconnect them with family and friends and bring back happy holiday memories.

Get Up and Grow	Rochdale - Kirkholt	£2,000.00	An arts & crafts pottery & painting project at Balderstone Library for people aged 50 and over living in Kirkholt
Get up and grow	Rochdale - Kirkholt	£2,000.00	An arts & crafts pottery & painting project at The Strand Community Hub for people aged 50 and over living in Kirkholt
Get Up and Grow	Rochdale - Kirkholt	£2,000.00	An arts & crafts pottery & painting project for people aged 50 and over who live at Arnold Bagnall Court, a Sheltered Housing Scheme in Kirkholt

Hope Citadel	Rochdale - Kirkholt	£1,770.00	A volunteer-led community gardening project for people aged 50 and over living in Kirkholt. Volunteer gardeners will work with older people to help them maintain and develop their gardens, grow vegetables and improve access.
Kirkholt Community Church	Rochdale - Kirkholt	£2,000.00	A “Seriously Crafty” weekly group for women aged 50 and over held at Kirkholt Community Church. Activities include sewing, knitting, crochet, quilting, card making and pottery.
Rochdale AFC Community Trust	Rochdale - Kirkholt	£1,500.00	This project will deliver physical and social activity sessions for people aged 50 and over who live in Kirkholt. Weekly sessions will include adapted games and sports that people may have played during childhood, strength and balance sessions and well-being walks around local landmarks.
Rochdale Boroughwide Housing - Walk and Talk Group	Rochdale - Kirkholt	£450.00	A Walk and Talk project for people aged 50 and over living in Kirkholt which will help bring people together, improve their health and well-being and help build social connections.
Rochdale Circle CIC t/a Heywood, Middleton & Rochdale Circle	Rochdale - Kirkholt	£1,320.00	The creation of a Kirkholt Choir. The group will meet weekly at The Strand Community Hub and Kirkholt Community Church. Trips and other social activities will also take place.
Beauty in the Community	Salford - Swinton	£1,972.25	A project called “Ageless Beauty” will deliver activities over a 6 week period, focusing on “Beauty Self-care” and will include manicures, pedicures, hand massages, hand and foot exercises and facial exercises. Other sessions will include bingo with a beauty related theme and prizes.
Critchley House Community Hub	Salford - Swinton	£1,950.00	This project will create age-friendly outdoor seating and an eating area at the front of Critchley House Community Hub to increase its accessibility for people aged 50 and over who live in Swinton.

Dancing with Dementia	Salford - Swinton	£1,920.00	A social eating project for older people living with dementia and their carers. A weekly session held at two local cafes in Swinton will provide an opportunity to share experiences and access peer support. Health care professionals will attend to offer care advice, support.
Ngamaba Community Path CIC	Salford - Swinton	£2,000.00	A physical activities project for men and women aged 50 and over living in Swinton. The project includes keep fit activity as well as lifestyle change information and advice.
Warm Hut UK	Salford - Swinton	£2,000.00	A lifestyle change and physical activities project for people aged 50 and over living in Swinton who are from African Francophone, Lusophone and Lingalophone backgrounds. Sessions include physical activities as well as support and advice on lifestyle and management of long-term medical conditions.
ItsHerstory CIC	Stockport - Reddish	£2,000.00	A "Living and working during and after menopause" project for women aged 55 and over, especially carers and women from BAME communities living in Reddish.
Reddish Vale Men in Sheds	Stockport - Reddish	£1,990.00	This project will extend the work of the Reddish Vale Men in Sheds group and develop/adapt the building's facilities to increase the diversity and reach of the group.
Signpost Stockport for Carers	Stockport - Reddish	£2,000.00	A project delivering a number of activities which will support and enable unpaid carers and former carers living in Reddish to connect with each other and receive support from their peers. This will involve nature walks in Reddish Vale, Time for a Pint male carers group in a local pub and Break for Breakfast/Brew groups in cafes.
Step Out Service - Age UK Stockport	Stockport - Reddish	£2,000.00	The creation of an accessible sensory garden and walkway in the grounds of the Step Out older people's day service in Reddish. Intergenerational 'plant, grow and eat' activities will be delivered with a local primary school.



We Care NW Ltd (BOOST)	Stockport - Reddish	£1, 960.00	This project will deliver weekly bowling sessions at Houldsworth Working Mens Club to people aged 50 and over who live in Reddish.
Academy HQ CIC	Tameside - Stalybridge	£2,000.00	“Young at Heart” will provide weekly activity sessions, including stretching, fun fitness dance sessions and mindful breathing. Monthly speakers will deliver sessions on first aid and how to tackle loneliness and refreshments and time to socialise will be included in each session
Carrbrook Resident’s Hub / Youcan Youth	Tameside - Stalybridge	£1,518.00	The “Monthly Us” project will provide a range of physical and social activity sessions. Activities include gardening, Tai Chi, armchair aerobics, bingo and afternoon tea.
Dukinfield & Stalybridge Rotary Club	Tameside - Stalybridge	£2,000.00	“Getting Together Project” will deliver a programme of “tea dances”, led by a trained dance instructor. As well as dancing there will be other entertainment and plenty of time and space to chat and catch up with each other.
George's Kitchen	Tameside - Stalybridge	£1,980.00	This project will develop the community kitchen at St George's Church in Stalybridge to deliver food provision and social eating to local residents aged 50 and over.
Made by Mortals	Tameside - Stalybridge	£2,000.00	A creative workshop project for people aged 50 and over living with long term health conditions. Sessions include creative writing, lyric writing, music making, acting and sound production and will culminate in the creation of an original podcast which will be shared with young people.
Melbourne Court Pet Therapy Sessions	Tameside - Stalybridge	£810.00	A project delivering pet therapy sessions to older people living with dementia who reside at Melbourne Court Extra Care Scheme in Stalybridge.
Noah’s A.R.T.	Tameside - Stalybridge	£1,990.00	A project which will recruit and train volunteers aged 50 and over to become Home Care Ambassadors who will deliver pet therapy sessions to older people living in care homes in Stalybridge.

St Paul's Church, Stalybridge	Tameside - Stalybridge	£1,717.77	This investment will be used to purchase shelters and improve the toilet facilities at St Paul's Church in Stalybridge to make a more accessible space for people aged 50 and over to take part in activities held in the church and its grounds.
Stalybridge Town Team	Tameside - Stalybridge	£2,000.00	This investment will be used to refurbish benches in the centre of Stalybridge to help create a more age-friendly place. The benches will be refurbished by Tameside's Men in Sheds group.
Kendal House Social Fund	Tameside - Stalybridge	£1,490.00	The Healthy Hearts and Minds project is an online and face to face physical and social activities project for community groups and people aged 50 and over who live at Kendal House in Stalybridge.
The Shed (Tameside)	Tameside - Stalybridge	£1,380.00	A Heritage Stories Memories project for older men living with dementia and their families and carers. Project participants will work with Tameside Local History and Archives to produce a personalised Heritage Stories and Memories storybook and toolkit of Stalybridge that will be shared with wider members of the community.
Age UK Trafford	Trafford - Clifford	£2,000.00	Trained advisors will deliver sessions providing information and advice to older Clifford residents and their carers at St John's Centre. People who want to access the service but unable to attend/travel will receive alternative support, such as home visit.
Sharon Youth Association	Trafford - Clifford	£2,000.00	The project is to develop the Centre's enclosed garden into an age friendly, multipurpose space with a seating area which will benefit older Clifford residents.
St Johns Centre	Trafford - Clifford	£1,995.50	A 'Try a Bike' scheme which will enable Asian women over the age of 50 to try cycling by loaning a bike with the option of purchasing or returning it. At the end of the project, participants can pay the small balance to purchase the bike.

St Johns Centre	Trafford - Clifford	£339.23	The project is to purchase equipment for the St John's Gardening group to make it more accessible to a wider range of people including older people with disabilities and/or reduced mobility.
St John's Centre	Trafford - Clifford	£2,000.00	A 10-week programme of hosted social fitness sessions for Clifford residents over the age of 50 to take place at St Johns Centre. Each session will incorporate exercise and time for socialising, with refreshments provided.
Stitched Up Community Benefit Society Ltd	Trafford - Clifford	£2,000.00	A weekly social sewing group, including drop-in sessions. There will be 8 facilitated sessions and the participants will be given support to continue the group beyond this self-managed.
The Urban Fitness Collective	Trafford - Clifford	£2,000.00	A cycling, coffee and chat club, facilitated by a Ride leader between September and November. 2 e-bikes will be purchased and donated bikes will be available for people wishing to participate who do not own a bike.
Trafford African Caribbean Seniors	Trafford - Clifford	£2,000.00	To fund memorial events to celebrate members of the organisation and the community who have lost their lives during the pandemic.
Women of Worth	Trafford - Clifford	£2,000.00	A weekly group for the African and Caribbean community. During the sessions, Caribbean meals will be served and therapeutic activities such as art classes, meditation, yoga and reflexology will be delivered by local providers.
Aspull Bowling Club	Wigan - Wigan North	£2,000.00	The bowling green will be made more accessible by the purchase of equipment and accessible outside seating. A defibrillator will also be purchased. A volunteer maintenance team will be formed to maintain the greens and surrounding areas.

Shevington and District Community Association	Wigan - Wigan North	£1,230.00	The project will involve the purchase of sports and recreational equipment that will benefit older Wigan North residents, including croquet sets, boccia set, petanque/boules sets, walking football equipment and art materials and equipment.
Standish Community Forum	Wigan - Wigan North	£2,000.00	Two 'Welcome Events' to give participants the opportunity to meet organisers of community groups and socialise. The project includes producing and distributing a brochure to residents over 50 containing information on what community groups there are in the village and how to get involved.
